EMT Course

The 228-hour program covers anatomy and physiology, initial patient survey and triage, airway management, oxygen therapy, and treatment of bleeding, shock, cardiac arrest, fractures, spinal injuries and other medical emergencies. Additional areas of study include automated external defibrillation, multi-lumen airways and general pharmacology.

The course is designed for anyone and is most beneficial for those interested in working in public safety, including fire, police and ambulance operations. Students who successfully complete one of these programs are eligible to take the National Registry Examination for Emergency Medical Technician.

Enrollment Requirements:

- 18 years old within one year of course completion
- No felony convictions
- High school diploma or G.E.D. (recommended)

Classes will be held Tuesdays, Thursdays 5:30PM – 10:30PM and Every Other Sunday All Day

Course completion date is Thursday March 29, 2012
