Using a combination of live fire and "Sim-Rounds" the shooter will progress through an intense hands-on-training session where you learn how to effectively use a firearm in many high stress situations. Technique is stressed as you learn how to search and clear a hallway and room, how to engage multiple targets, fire from various points behind a barricade, shoot and move, strong hand and weak hand techniques and how to safely carry and engage with a firearm inside of a vehicle. Emphasis will be placed on how to practice most constructively and how to evaluate and track your own skill level. This is an intense firearms based course that requires flexibility, shooting in various lighting conditions and exposure to the elements. Ice Storms, Power Outages, Floods, Tornado, Man Caused Disaster can all force you from your home in minutes or can trap you in your home for days. A 72 hour emergency kit will give you all of the basic necessities to survive until help arrives. This class covers that basics of how to build a kit and provides some of the basic requirements to begin assembly of this potentially life-saving kit. The course also covers the basics of building a personal and family disaster plan.
