The Michigan Association of Fire Chiefs is sponsoring and Hartland Area Fire Authority is Hosting Fire Service Safety Culture: Who Protects Firefighters from Firefighters? (FO349).

This is a two day course that will help fire service personnel identify their present fire service safety culture, explain how culture drives safety behavior, identify risk management strategies and develop a fire service safety culture intervention plan to reduce injury and death to firefighters in their organization. The course content includes National Institute for Occupational Health and Safety and Health (NIOSH) Firefighter Fatality Investigation and Prevention reports, organizational change, leadership models and risk control systems.

At the end of the course, students will be evaluated through a 25-question multiple-choice examination. A final grade will be provided to each student. The minimum score needed to pass is 70.
