MICHIGAN FIRE SERVICE INSTRUCTOR'S ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Michigan Fire Service Instructors Association has established an annual educational scholarship grant program. Awards will be made each year to high school graduates to assist in paying tuition at accredited institutions whether they are Vocational/Technical School, a community college or a four-year college/university. One grant in the amount of \$500 will be made annually.

ELIGIBILITY:

- 1. Limited to members in good standing and their immediate family.
- 2. Applicants must have applied to or been accepted to an accredited college or vocations/technical school. Awards can be made to individuals pursuing any type of higher education course of study; however, individuals studying the field of fire science or related field in fire service will have preference in the award selection process.

APPLICATION:

Make sure your application is complete. The scholarship grant committee will review applications and make recommendations. The MFSIA Executive Board will consider the committee recommendations and make final selections. Recipients will be notified of their award and invited to the annual banquet.

The award check will be made payable to the recipient. Upon the recommendation of the scholarship committee, checks may be made to cover associated expenses (i.e.: books, etc). The scholarship committee may also request a receipt from the recipient showing when and how the award was spent.

All information will be classified as confidential and treated in a professional manner.
